1.0 Purpose

The Health and Safety of participants, dancers, instructors, volunteers and everyone concerned with Tatry is of paramount importance. It is a shared responsibility that as much as possible activities, equipment and the environment are not likely to result in harm or damage either physical or psychological to themselves, or anyone involved in the Tatry Organisation.

2.0 Policy Details

All people involved with Tatry will

- conduct themselves in a healthy and safe manner at rehearsal and performances taking due care for themselves and others
- ensure they do not endanger any other person through any act or omission
- cooperate and respond to instructor's/ committee's instruction
- ensure they are not in a state that may endanger their own safety or safety of others
- challenge unsafe behaviours in others
- report any injuries or incidents to the President

All dancers/instructors will be notified of

- emergency exits
- location of the first aid box
- location of firefighting equipment
- identification of first aiders

All dancers/instructors will

check that the floor is clean and clear of obstacles prior to commencing dancing

All dancers will ensure they are appropriately warmed up prior to commencing dancing

Environment and general safety

- General areas, doorways and corridors will be kept clear and tidy
- Ladder to be used when required, no-one is to stand on chairs
- Electrical cords and extension cords are to be appropriately rated for the task, well maintained and regularly examined for signs of wear and tear
- Toilets will have soap available, rubbish bins will be provided and be cleaned regularly
- All electrical equipment used shall be in good working order and plugged in to a portable RCD (Residual Current Device) when in use
- No power boards/ electrical cords will be used near water
- Care to be taken by dancers when dancing and using props such as canes/ axes
